DRESS STANDARDS REQUIRED OF ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS

- Men are to wear collars shirts, trousers and covered footwear. Jackets are preferred in the dining room .
- Ladies are expected to dress with similar formality.
- **Jeans and Joggers** are not acceptable.
- Casual attire is permitted for in-house guests only during breakfast and when leaving or entering the club and for members using the athletic club.
- Dress code will be enforced with entry and service refused.

MOBILE PHONE USAGE

- Mobile phone usage is not permitted in the dining room, reading room, stairwell and other public areas of the club.
- You may use your mobile phone in the strangers room located near the reception desk or in the phone booths located on Level 3.

Dress Code

Members and guests are required to dress in good taste, be neat and tidy at all times and thus maintain the dignity and standard of the Club.

Gentleman as a minimum, are required to wear a collared shirt, with trousers and covered footwear.

Ladies are expected to dress with commensurate formality according to the occasion and within the spirit of these rules. **(NOTE: Jeans and trainers are not permitted in the club)**

Harbour Room Restaurant – Breakfast period

In-house members and guests may wear casual attire during the breakfast period.

In-House Members and Guests

Casual attire may be worn when entering and leaving the club (including check-in and check-out) and accessing the gym facilities. **(NOTE: Jeans and trainers are not permitted in the club)**

Management retain the ole discretion to refuse entry and or service to those people not complying with the above regulations and is the sole arbiter on acceptable standard of dress

Definition of “Guest”

In accordance with Registered clubs Act, the definition of a guest of a member of this club means a person:

- (a) whose name and address is countersigned by the member and entered in a register kept for this purpose by the club, and
- (b) who, at all times while on the club premises, remains in the reasonable company of the member, and
- (c) who does not remain on the club premises any longer than the member
